Year 1 - 4	Team Theme After school club	£1500	All children in these year groups will be offered an after school club which will include multisport. The children will work on skills previously taught and develop their accuracy and confidence.
Years R,1,2,3,4	Vertigo Climbing Wall	£250	Children will push their boundaries and conquer their fears through an adventurous activity. This will teach resilience and challenge learners to exceed their expectations of themselves. This will allow teachers to take appropriate risks in their delivery of physical activity.
All years	Money kept aside for possible sporting events that may take place later in school year.	£1000	Due to the current situation we are unable to organise any events off site. We would like to keep back a proportion of the budget in case this changes later in the school year.
EYFS	Development of Reception class outside area to promote Physical development	£5000	Children will have access on a daily basis to apparatus that will help develop and promote their physical development and gross motor skills.
Whole School	Purchase of IPEP	£594	This online PE programme used to teach differentiated lessons. It is a way for the PE co-ordinator to assess and monitor. It teaches lessons that show clear progression across the school.
Whole School	Purchase of new PE equipment to enhance use of IPEP	£1000	IPEP has been newly introduced to schools and needs some new equipment to deliver it fully.
Sport Coaches	Purchase of an ipad for Team theme to use when delivering our PE lessons (to be kept in school)	£300	To help enhance and assess children during PE sessions. Photos can be uploaded onto the IPEP system so the PE coordinator can carefully monitor all year groups.
