Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all the parents who have let us know that they are following the government's advice on self-isolating for 7 days due to a fever or new persistent cough.

Please could we remind parents that should your child be off school unwell for any reason, you must inform the school office by 9am on the first day of their absence, this can be via email, phone or ParentMail.

The class teachers have been informed and they will be emailing you with learning for your children whilst they are absent.

As a school, we are receiving daily updates, and will pass on any changes to you as soon as we know, but we do not have any more information than anybody else. We are all in this together.

If it comes to the school having to close, we will provide learning for the children at home as closely matched to what they would be doing in school as possible. In preparation for this, please make sure that we have the best email address to send this to you. If you do not have internet access at home, please let us know and we will arrange for learning to be sent an alternative way. All the children (apart from Nursery) are bringing an exercise book home with them today. Please keep this safe and do not use it until we have any further information.

Regarding parents consultations this week, we have agreed that we will send the forms home for your child/children and give you a telephone call at your set time, rather than coming into school.

We had planned for Year 4 to have their class assembly on Wednesday morning, but to reduce the number of people in close proximity we have made the decision to video this instead. We will then send it out to Year 4 parents to see. If you would prefer your child not to take part, please let us know as soon as possible.

We have just received information, that the school council trip due to take place on Wednesday has been postponed. At this moment in time we are not making definite decisions whether to cancel other trips we have planned, but will let you know in due course.

For your information, we do have foodbank vouchers in school. If you would benefit from one of these, please enquire at the school office.

I want to thank you all for your patience, understanding and calmness during this uncertain time.
