'Learning to Learn' at Oakhurst

At Oakhurst our aim is to give children the skills that they need to be learners for life. We have been looking at the skills that are needed to be a good learner and as a school, we have come up with what we feel are the four most important ones.

In school we will be using these words and talking about what they look like throughout the school day. Occasionally, we will be giving special stickers when the children exhibit certain learning skills. If your child has a sticker it would be great if you could ask them what they did and what it was they were learning to promote the use of these words.

The words are (the four Rs):

Ready (Roxy Rabbit)- Has equipment ready. Listens and is interested. Believes in him/herself



Resourceful (Sydney Squirrel)- Asks questions and knows what to use to help them with their learning



Resilient (Trek Tortoise)- Stay positive, keep practising and don't give up!



Reflective (Otis Owl)- Learns from mistakes and grows from experience. Thinks about how they have learned in the past
